This fun, funky beach town boasts a broad beach, long pier and old-timey main drag dotted with antique stores, surf shops and art galleries. Follow your nose to local favorite **Brown Butter Cookie Co.**

LOS OSOS-BAYWOOD PARK: Anchored by Montaña de Oro State Park, Los Osos-Baywood Park is an oasis of natural serenity. Go tidepooling, kayak in the estuary and walk through the Elfin Forest.

Agricultural bounty, wine lands and character-rich towns beckon foodies and families

Atascadero

Known as A-Town to locals, Atascadero is experiencing an exciting renaissance as younger makers and entrepreneurs make their marks. Sample farm-fresh fare, stroll the historic downtown and admire the vibrant street art and 1918 landmark City Hall.

Templeton

This farming community is a must-stop for food and wine aficionados with more than a dozen wine tasting rooms (including **Epoch Estate Wines**), an olive oil farm and a charming historic Main Street.

Paso Robles

Paso Robles' walkable town center offers gourmet cuisine, wine tasting rooms, boutique hotels and enticing shops. In addition to wine trails in the surrounding countryside, **Tin City** is a culinary destination on the outskirts of town; it's home to craft brewers, boutique wineries and a Michelin-starred eatery. After the sun goes down, **Sensorio Paso Robles'** light installations shine brightly.

Santa Margarita

Santa Margarita is the gateway to SLO CAL's rural northern interior region. Zip-line and horseback ride at **Santa Margarita Ranch** and hike through the **Carrizo Plain National Monument**. Kayak and camp by **Santa Margarita Lake** and sip worldclass wines among the vines.

San Miguel

From historic **Mission San Miguel Arcángel** and the **Pleasant Valley Wine Trail** to fruit orchards and family farms, San Miguel serves up authentic, down-home hospitality.


San Luis Obispo






San Luis Obispo County Regional Airport offers nonstop connections to Dallas, Denver, Las Vegas (seasonal), Los Angeles, Phoenix, Portland, San Diego, San Francisco and Seattle. **ACI Jet** offers private charter service to Oceano, San Luis Obispo and Paso Robles.

By Rail

Amtrak's Pacific Surfliner stops at the Grover Beach and City of San Luis Obispo stations daily and the *Coast Starlight* stops in the City of San Luis Obispo and Paso Robles.

By Car

Located midway between Los Angeles and San Francisco, SLO CAL is accessible via US-101, Route 1 and I-5 (via CA-41, CA-46 or CA-166).



Morro Bay Oyster Co. founder Neal Maloney has thoughtfully grown his business anchored in the nutrient-rich waters of Morro Bay.

The sustainable aquaculture farm harvests premium oysters coveted by consumers and chefs across California and the U.S.

Scalifornia's leading oyster farms, Morro Bay Oyster Co., established in 2008. Just four years after graduating college and learning about oyster farming under the tutelage of his former mentor at Tomales Bay Oyster Compa-



ny, marine biologist Neal Maloney purchased the 134acre production farm and has been growing the operation ever since. Maloney start-

ed selling directly to Central Coast

restaurants and as his reputation grew, began shipping to chefs farther afield. Today, Morro Bay Oyster Co. distributes more than one million oysters across the country every year—that number is set to grow with the upcoming expansion of their mariculture footprint.

The "merroir" of the bay plays a huge role in the quality and character of the in-demand oysters. "Every 28 hours, our bay turns over its entire volume," Maloney explained. "We have a steep drop off with a continental shelf right off the coast and it gets windy. That brings deep nutrient-rich water up to the shore with the turning tides and



that volume turnover brings all those nutrients into our bay." A large freshwater aquifer feeds the creek that flows across the farm, also benefiting the oysters. "That fresh water is what translates to sweet on your palate."

Not only are oysters highly nutritious, the bivalves are one of the most sustainable seafoods in the food chain. An adult oyster filters roughly 50 gallons of seawater daily, and their reefs protect sensitive habitats. So it's only natural that sustainability is paramount to the company's operation. They invest in reusable plastic mesh bags that last decades. "The mesh creates an artificial reef, so while they're deployed in the water a host of other organisms are using those bags as well," Maloney said.

In addition to creating a safe habitat for sea life on the mudflats, the oysters are filtering out sediment, resulting in clearer water that allows marine plants like eelgrass to grow and thrive. "As we grow our farm and expand, it's exciting to see that we're also able to do that in a low impactful way to allow for nature to coexist."





LO CAL is one of the most watched winemaking destinations in the

western U.S. While grapes were first cultivated locally dating back to the Mission Era and European immigrants planted vineyards in the 1800s, the contemporary wine industry really started to take root in the late 1970s as



Rhône and Bordeaux varietals took to the growing conditions. In the 1980s, the county's first American Viticultural Areas (AVAs) were officially designated and SLO CAL's global profile began building in the 1990s. The early aughts saw an influx of new investment via tech money complemented by fresh, young talent graduating

from Cal Poly's new viticultural program, creating an environment ripe for growth, experimentation and innovation.

To this day, wine consumers and novice tasters have much to discover in SLO CALthe wine industry is always evolving and making room for new players. Wine grapes are the area's most lucrative crop, accounting for nearly 30% of the county's total agricultural sales in 2023.

SLO CAL winemakers are known for doing things their own way, and being down-toearth and inclusive is part of the culture. Here, you are invited to be curious, ask questions and connect with the people behind the wine, be they winemakers, apprentices, part of the family business or seasoned hospitality professionals. All you need is an open mind and palate to make SLO CAL wine country your own. Cheers!





Urban Tasting Rooms

You don't have to go deep into wine country to sample intriguing wines thanks to the many urban tasting rooms. Visit **Brochelle Vineyards, Herman Story Wines, Paso Robles Wine Merchant, Symbiosis Wines** and **Cali-Paso** in Paso Robles. Tin City houses dozens of wineries in a modern, industrial setting. In San Luis Obispo, the urban wine trail includes **Dunites Wine Co., Stephen Ross Wine Cellars** and **Region SLO**. Arroyo Grande's walkable village is home to **Timbre Winery** and **Verdad and Lindquist Family Wines**, and Cambria's village offers **Black Hand Cellars**.

View Finder

It's all about the scenery at **Hearst Ranch Winery** in San Simeon, the only winery right on the water where you can sample wines while enjoying fresh sea breezes. **Daou Vineyard & Winery** is legendary for its luxurious tasting experience complete with 360-degree vistas from its namesake mountaintop in the Adelaida District. **PasoPort** also has a prime perch to share their collection of wines, ports and spirits. And **Talley Vineyards** pours single-vineyard chardonnays and pinot noirs with sweeping Arroyo Grande mountain views.

Calling All Pilots!

Guests can pre-arrange to fly into **Halter Ranch** and land on the winery's airstrip. Enjoy lunch and buy a few bottles to fly home with.

Explore the Caves

Eberle Winery's best-kept secret is a 16,800-square-foot network of wine caves and winding tunnels that sit 30 feet beneath the winery. Book a 90-minute VIP Tasting to experience the wine caves firsthand followed by a tasting in the Cave Grotto.

Unique Pairings

Ulloa Cellars' winemaker Nancy Ulloa harnesses the energy of crystals in her winemaking process and

shares her insights via guided wine and crystal pairings. LXV Wine takes tasters on a sensory journey with a Wine & Flavors Flight featuring different spice blends (sprinkled atop cheese) specifically paired to each featured wine. Niner Wine Estates also serves up exquisite flavors with their ever-changing gourmet lunch menu schowcasing the chef's garden. Robert Hall Winery offers an e-bike tour of their sustainably farmed vineyards followed by a tasting flight accompanied by a cheeseboard. Work up an appetite zip-lining above the vineyards before lunch and a tasting at Ancient Peaks Winery.

CASS Winery is a Certified California Sustainable Winery focused on water conservation, energy management and biodiversity preservation. **AmByth Estate** and **Maha Estate** are Certified Biodynamic, going a step further to employ practices such as livestock integration and working with the moon cycles. **Chamisal Vineyards** is SIP Certified and committed to regenerative agricultural practices, introducing biody-

namic methods as well as planting and maintaining a community garden that directly supports the San Luis Obispo Food Bank.

Shale Oak Winery and Niner Wine Estates are housed in state-of-the-art, LEED Certified buildings that help to conserve resources to further lessen the carbon footprint of the sustainable wineries.

Women in Wine

Female winemakers and entrepreneurs are making a mark in SLO CAL's wine world. Meet three women who embody the talent, drive and vision it takes to carve out a successful career in the wine industry.



Brianne Engles

WINEMAKER AT CHAMISAL VINEYARDS

A Central Coast native, Brianne Engles started working at a high-end restaurant at the young age of 15, exposing her to the world of wine. She went on to earn a bachelor's degree in Wine and Viticulture at Cal Poly and also holds the Level 3 Advanced Certification with The Wine & Spirit Education Trust. Her 17 years of winemaking have included stints in Australia and Napa Valley before landing in SLO CAL as lead winemaker at Chamisal Vineyards, where she captures the essence of Central Coast sunshine and soil in each vintage.

What makes SLO CAL such an extraordinary place to make wine?

San Luis Obispo has a unique climate and terroir due to its close proximity to the coast, just five miles away, making it the coolest region in California. This coastal influence significantly shapes the style of wines. Additionally, SLO is a relatively young wine-growing region, not constrained by traditional wine genres. This allows for significant innovation and

experimentation with cool climate varieties, so it's a really exciting place to make wine.



What does being part of such a strong community of female winemakers mean to you?

CHAMISAL

MALENE

The Central Coast is home to a large population of female winemakers and institutions like Cal Poly are nurturing many new women winemakers including my graduation cohort. Being part of such a strong community means having a profound sense of support and fellowship. We regularly share ideas, talk shop and

lean on each other for support. I am part of a tasting group with fellow female winemakers—whom I greatly respect—that has been running for three years. This group has been invaluable for sharing insights and fostering a collaborative spirit.

How do you see SLO CAL's wine scene evolving?


What excites me most is the momentum brought by the new SLO Coast AVA. Although the region is still somewhat under the radar, it is gaining recognition. There are many young, talented winemakers emerging at the helm of the local industry and pushing it forward with sustainable, regenerative viticulture and innovative winemaking practices.



Monica Villicana

CO-OWNER OF VILLICANA WINERY & RE:FIND SPIRITS

> Monica Villicana and her husband. Alex. were wine appreciators living and working in Los Angeles and frequenting Paso Robles when they caught the bug to make it a permanent lifestyle in the 1990s. After building their Villicana Winery business from the ground up and being part of an exciting period of collaboration and growth in SLO CAL's wine industry, they saw an opportunity to reduce their waste and distill spirits from their wine by-products. **Re:Find Spirits** became one of the first distilleries in the region.



What was it like being so hands-on during the wine industry's growth in the late 1990s and 2000s?

It was a lot of youth, and people were excited. They were following their dreams, they weren't following rules. They were doing things that they wanted to do. They were doing blends that they weren't doing up in Napa. You were seeing Rhônes being blended with Bordeaux. And it was just this vibrance of energy. Collaboration allowed us all to build these wineries from scratch, and we got more and more involved in the community. If you were

having difficulties, you'd call another vintner and [explain your challege] and they would help you, and that was really, really cool.

What do you appreciate about SLO CAL's vibrant maker culture today?

The culture in SLO CAL is unique. It is a community of "can do" makers doing what they are passionate about. They are not chasing traditions or how things are always done, but rather forging their own path in an authentic way. And, they are doing it in the spirit of community. It is a network of makers supporting each other and collaborating whenever possible.

What excites you most about the future?

SLO Cal is a trailblazing community that is attracting more and more foodies interested in all aspects of the culinary spectrum. What is so exciting is that visitors come for the great products and are hooked by the down-toearth, authentic

vibe, which keeps them coming back for more.

Women in Wine



Neeta Mittal

CO-OWNER OF LXV WINE

A native of India. Neeta Mittal and her husband. Kunal. discovered Paso Robles wine country by happenstance—they were flying to Napa from Los Angeles and ended up landing in Paso Robles due to fog. After their first eye-opening exploration along Vineyard Drive, they were hooked. Their newfound passion for the region and the wines of Bordeaux inspired them to make Paso Robles their home. Over the span of 14 years, they grew LXV Wine from a modest 100-casesa-year hobby project to a 5,000-cases-a-year business.

How did you get into winemaking in SLO CAL?

We were very hungry to be a part of this culture after buying property here. We quickly realized that this very intelligent and astute group of people [making wine] gravitate towards those who are really serious about the art and craft of wine. They really want people who are shepherds, who are thinking about the land and the legacy, and that changed our perspective. So it was from outside inside in that sense. and then for us, from inside out.

being a part

of that process

also



changed things for us, where we saw there is so much more to this than having a wine brand.

What role does sustainability play in your business?

The vinevard is at the heart of everything that we do. It is a poster child for everything organic. We have a small olive orchard in the front because we believe in biodiversity. We work with our neighbor [who has cows] on a compost program and we just

received a grant from the USDA to work on soil amendment and soil studies. We named the vineyard *armaan*, which means "a cherished dream" in Urdu.

What does being a part of SLO CAL's culinary community mean to you?

San Luis Obispo County is my India, it's that fabric that I grew up in. There's an intimacy in the ecosystem here. I think the culinary scene is so expansive, and to be a part of that on the receiving end or on the giving end, both have been really exciting. And in one way or the other. I'm able to weave that Indian story into what I do and so that also gives you a feeling of being tethered and being a part of something that's rooted.

SLO CAL's natural world is one big playground. From untouched beaches and inviting surf breaks to a vast network of hiking and biking trails and adventure outfitters, outdoor enthusiasts have an epic line-up to choose from. Add grounding wellness therapies and rituals to the equation and SLO CAL is the ultimate place to recharge and reset.



From sandy beaches to towering cliffs, explore the diverse San Luis Obispo County coast

Stretching for **100 miles** along the Pacific Ocean, SLO CAL's coastline offers endless adventure. Whether you're looking for classic beaches or more secluded spots to reconnect with the natural world, experience the California coast at its very best.

THE WILDER COAST

Considered "the largest intact coastal dune ecosystem on Earth," the **Guadalupe-Nipomo Dunes** complex extends for 18 miles south from Pismo Beach. Tucked within this sea of sand, **Oso Flaco Lake** is a rare coastal freshwater lake, where a trail and bridge offer outstanding bird-watching and access to a wild beach.

At 8,000-acre **Montaña de Oro State Park** near Los Osos, the Bluff Trail runs for two miles as it edges meadows of spring wildflowers and



craggy coves with dramatic rock formations.

Cayuco

Backed by rolling dunes and with definitive views of iconic Morro Rock, **Morro Strand State Beach** extends for three miles along Estero Bay's churning waves between Cayucos and Morro Bay. Birders flock here to observe large numbers of migratory shorebird species, including thousands of long-billed curlews.

The northern elephant seals that spend parts of their year at **Piedras Blancas Elephant Seal Rookery** are the county's heavyweight champs. Known as "beach masters," the largest males can weigh 5,000 pounds and aggressively defend their territories after returning in late November. Docents are on hand to explain the annual life cycle of these seals, whose population has grown to 25,000 animals along an eightmile stretch north of Cambria.

Catch a Wave

FIND YOUR OPTIMAL SURF BREAK.

SLO CAL boasts a vibrant surf culture and a big selection of breaks. You'll find outstanding surf shops, such as SLO's Central Coast Surfboards (the county's oldest) and Pismo Beach's Esteem Surf Co. Pismo's surfing action centers on the landmark, 1,250-foot Pismo Beach Pier, with waves that the forecasting site surfline.com describes as "one of the more consistent and shapely of all Central Coast beach breaks." Beach breaks certainly rule in the county, including along Cayucos Pier, and on the north side of Morro Rock, which has hosted World Surfing League longboard qualifying events. Below San Simeon's bluffs, Pico Creek has a wilder feel and a reef break that produces dependable surf, especially in February.






FIND THE ENDLESS SUMMER

With miles of flat sands ideal for beach walks at sunset, anglers casting for surfperch from the pier and a vintage downtown just steps from the shore, **Pismo Beach** is the very incarnation of a California beach town. Woodies, waves and even the occasional whale lend a timeless appeal. Cows meet cowabunga in **Cayucos**, thanks to its unique mix of ranching traditions and surf town ways. Watch sunsets from the 1872 pier and take your canine pal for a walk on the dog-friendly beach. And just north of town, trails at Estero Bluffs State Park lead along miles of unspoiled coastline.

Tucked inside a quiet bay ideal for kayaking, Avila Beach enjoys a reputation for its sunny microclimate and warm ocean temperatures; it's the perfect spot for hanging out on the beach but also a versatile destination where you can go whale-watching in the morning and wine tasting in the afternoon.



Did You Say Surfing Goats?

If surfing's GOATs (Greatest of All Time) search the world for 100-foot waves, Pismo Beach's Surfing Goats is more modest in its ambitions. Founded by Dana McGregor, this unique company brings together stoke and goatswith hooves. No matter your surfing skills (or lack thereof), you can take lessons that include rides on a wave board with yes, a goat. And think your dog could be a ripper? McGregor even teaches pets how to hang ten.

HAPPY TRAILS

Wheelchair friendly trails include **Railroad Bike Path** in San Luis Obispo, **Bluff Trail** in **Montaña de Oro State Park** and **Meadowpark Trail** in San Luis Obispo. The San Luis Obispo Land Conservancy has a partnership with Positive Ride to make **Pismo Preserve** accessible to wheelchair users with Freedom Trax. **Field of Lights at Sensorio** is wheelchair accessible, including ADA parking and restrooms.

BEACH WHEELCHAIRS

Beach wheelchairs are available at **Pismo State Beach**, which stretches from Grover Beach to Oceano; the City of Pismo Beach also offers two beach wheelchairs for use at no charge via the **Sand Castle Inn.** The City of Morro Bay offers complimentary beach wheelchairs through **Jack's Helping Hand**.

ADAPTIVE ADVENTURES

Positive Ride specializes in creating adaptive adventures that get people with mobility challenges outdoors and off the pavement with Freedom Trax, a device that quickly and temporarily converts a manual wheelchair into a battery-powered, all-terrain vehicle that can easily traverse a variety of different terrains. Pismo Beach-headquartered **Amp Surf** provides adaptive surf therapy clinics for adults and children with disabilities.


ANGLING FOR LAKE LIFE

Arroyo Grande's Lake Lopez Marina rents kayaks, paddleboards, boats and waverunners—among other water toys. The lake is a year-round fishing destination for large and smallmouth bass, crappie, sunfish and catfish; fishing gear can be picked up at the Marina.



PADDLE POWER

With so much coastline to explore, kayaking opportunities abound. Rent from Avila Beach Paddle Sports and get tips for paddling out to Port San Luis Lighthouse and a private beach. Central Coast Kayaks hosts a three-hour tour that explores the Pismo Beach Caves. while Central Coast Outdoors leads a variety of guided paddles around Morro Bay, including some that go out to Morro Bay Oyster Co.'s farm for an up-close look at the aquaculture operation.





FLY HIGH

Margarita Adventures leads a thrilling zip-line tour at historic Santa Margarita Ranch. Soar above vineyards and oak trees as you complete the six zip-line course spanning 7,500 feet. You'll also cross a suspension bridge, spot wildlife and get a guided tour of the ranch in the 2.5-hour experience. *Note: height and age limits apply.*

ALL THE PRETTY HORSES

As a genuine ranching community, equestrian culture is synonymous with SLO CAL. **Central Coast Trailrides** guides scenic horseback rides at CASS Vineyard & Winery and Santa Margarita Ranch. Also in Paso Robles wine country, **Shangri-La Ranch Horseback** Adventures is another outfitter leading rides in a remote, rural setting. On the Cambria coast, **Covell Ranch** is one of only five places in the country that offers Clydesdale trail rides on their family ranch that has been breeding the horses for more than 40 years.

CATCH AIR ON THE DUNES

The Oceano Dunes Complex is a mustsee in SLO CAL, and there's no better way to take them in than on an ATV. Several companies offer ATV rentals out of Pismo Beach and Grover Beach, with different vehicle types for kids and adults, as well as passenger capacity and experience level. If you want to let someone else do the driving, consider a tour with **Xtreme Hummer Adventures**.

A WHALE TALE: SLO CAL's coast is on the migratory path of majestic California gray whales, blue whales and humpback whales. Head out to sea for a day of whale watching with charter companies such as **Avila Beach Whale Watching**.

 The region's iconic
 Nine Sisters is a chain of volcanic plugs stretching from Morro Rock to the City of San Luis Obispo, creating prime peaks for hikers. The most popular,
 Cerro San Luis (a.k.a. Madonna Mountain) is four-miles roundtrip with views of the Pacific Ocean from the 1,000-foot peak.

• The four-mile round-trip hike to **Montaña de Oro State Park**'s 1,347-foot Valencia Peak delivers spectacular views that extend for 60 miles. In spring, California poppies and lupine border the trail on the 1,200-foot climb to the summit.

• Cerro Alto literally means "high hill" in Spanish and this 2,615foot peak between Atascadero and Morro Bay certainly lives up to its name. A mostly unshaded 5.3-mile loop with a 1,600-foot climb begins at Cerro Alto Campground. From the summit (where a fire lookout once stood) you can see Morro Rock and, during prime conditions, the distant Sierra Nevada



Coastal Rambles FOR MELLOW SEASIDE STROLLS

 For gentle walks, it's tough to beat
 Cambria's mile-long oceanfront boardwalks.
 The boardwalk along
 Moonstone Beach has stairways to the beach, where you'll find the iridescent stones that give this stretch its name. At **Fiscalini Ranch**, the Bluff Trail edges rocky coves with sea otters in the surf and harbor seals on reefs. Combine it with the Marine Terrace Trail for a 1.6-mile loop.



Rent an E-Bike

Getting around SLO CAL without a car has never been easier thanks to the extensive network of bike routes and bike rental outfitters. Even if you only ride occasionally, an e-bike will boost you up hills and make pedaling against the wind, well, a breeze. Riding a bike is both good for you and the environment because you'll get exercise while doing your part to reduce auto emissions.

• Between Cambria and Cayucos, threemile round-trip hikes at Harmony Headlands State Park lead through onetime dairy lands and to isolated bluffs above the crashing waves. And at the 880-acre **Pismo** Preserve, hikers and bicyclists climb through oak woodlands to reach sweeping coastal panoramas along an 11-mile trail network high above Pismo Beach.

Cycling Adventures

EXPLORE BY BIKE AND TAKE IN THE SCENERY

• A perfect family ride, the **Bob Jones "City to the Sea" Trail** runs for a few miles beneath a canopy of coast live oaks and sycamores along San Luis Creek between U.S. 101 and the heart of Avila Beach.

• At Irish Hills Natural **Reserve**, on the edge of San Luis Obispo, mountain bikers take on stretches of technical single track and use connecting trails to extend rides into nearby Johnson Ranch Open Space. And with coastal trips along Highway 1 to Ragged Point and long, picturesque routes that travel among the vineyards of the Edna Valley and Paso Robles





The visitor center and gift shop are open without tour reservations. Shown on a five-story screen, the film *Hearst Castle: Building the Dream* is included with tours. Movie tickets can also be purchased separately. ADA accessible tours are also offered. **T** thas been said that a man's home is his castle. But for William Randolph Hearst, a castle was his home. The famed media mogul, art collector and political figure was never one to do things in small ways. Nor, with his wealth and power, did he need to.

In 1865, Hearst's grandfather purchased a 40,000-acre ranch near San Simeon that would grow to 250,000 acres by the time Hearst inherited the land. Hearst had grown up camping on a 1,600-foot promontory known as Camp Hill and said, "I would rather spend a month here than any place in the world."

Over the years, Hearst continued to vacation with

his family in furnished tents on Camp Hill before finally deciding he wanted to "build a little something" that would become Hearst Castle. In 1919, he hired renowned architect Julia Morgan and construction began. Hearst and Morgan collaborated on the Spanish Colonial and Mediterranean Revival estate for 28 years.

Come to this 165-room, 127acre estate and you'll discover an earthly paradise of lavish gardens and shimmering pools. Four major structures incorporate the paintings and antiquities Hearst collected, as well as the architectural elements that he salvaged from buildings around the world.



How to Experience Hearst Castle

IT TAKES MORE THAN ONE VISIT TO TRULY SEE ALL OF HEARST CASTLE.

Offering an overview of the main building known as Casa Grande, the **Grand Rooms Tour** is considered the classic introduction to the castle.

The Upstairs Suite Tour takes you into such areas as Hearst's Gothic Suite in Casa Grande, while the Cottages & Kitchen Tour explores the estate's ornate cottages.

Architectural buffs can choose from tours that emphasize the estate's design: **The Designing the Dream Tour** traces the evolution of the castle's architecture over nearly three decades, while the immersive and intimate **Julia Morgan Tour** examines the great architect's career as docents lead you throughout the castle, including areas inaccessible on other tours.

Step Back in Time

SLO CAL is home to two of California's 21 historic missions that formed the El Camino Real from San Diego to Sonoma. Founded in 1772, **Mission San Luis Obispo de Tolosa** is an anchor of downtown SLO. Its museum is filled with exhibits recounting local history, mission life and Native



Public Art Abounds Explore more than 30 murals on the SLO CAL Mural Trail. Download the map to plan your route. American artifacts. Further north, **Mission San Miguel** was established in 1797, and also has a museum and gift shop.

Visual Arts San Luis Obispo Museum of Art is a small but mighty contemporary art museum in San Luis Obispo's cultural corridor with two gallery spaces and outdoor murals. Visual arts appreciators will also want to check out **Sculptera Winery & Sculpture Garden** in Paso Robles featuring larger-than-life sculptures.

The Need for Speed

Set on the grounds of a World War II Air Force Base, **Estrella Warbird Museum** in Paso Robles is dedicated to the restoration and preservation of military aircraft, vehicles and memorabilia. Admission also gives you access to the **Woodland Automobile Display** focused on auto racing. Boats and all things seafaring are the focus at **Morro Bay Maritime Museum**. See the historic tugboat *Alma* and explore *DSRV Avalon*, one of only two Cold War-era rescue submarines developed by the U.S. Navy that was featured in the 1990 film *The Hunt for Red October*.



Secret Garden

LEARN ABOUT NATIVE PLANTS AT SAN LUIS OBISPO BOTANICAL GARDEN.

Learn about local animals, flowers and volcanoes on the Discovery Trail. Check out exhibits dedicated to Mediterranean growing regions around the world and let the kids run free in the Children's Garden.

Candles for the People

Karla Wenger, co-founder of The Mayan Collective and co-owner of Greenhouse Coffee Co., introduced the first candle bars to the Central Coast

Back in 2019, Karla Wenger and her husband, Spencer, came up with the idea to sell handmade, clean-burning candles to raise money to support families in need in Guatemala. "We started in our home kitchen, and then we progressed to have a first storefront in Pismo," she recalled. "We moved to Arroyo Grande and we've just opened our second location in San Luis Obispo at the SLO Ranch." The two brick-and-mortar stores are far from ordinary. The Mayan Collective has a DIY candle bar at both locations, where customers can "Pop in and Pour" to personalize a 14 oz. candle of their own.

Their clean wellness line also includes bath and body products, kitchen soaps and room sprays. Scented items are made to order and can be replenished at the refill station. "There are a lot of endocrine disruptors in everyday things in your house, like cleaning supplies," Wenger explained of their focus on non-toxic materials. Sustainability is important to the Wengers too, between the eco-friendly materials they use and minimizing waste with their refill station. The new SLO Ranch store also includes their own line of "SLO Life" merch along with items by other local artists they admire.

Coastal Inspired Jewels

Artist and surfer Abby Ahlgrim's Surf Gems jewelry line features one-of-a-kind accessories made with recycled surfboard resin

During the pandemic, Abby Ahlgrim took the time to learn to surf. The chilly waters in Morro Bay inspired her to find a way to bring some color and femininity into her surf style. "Everyone is required to wear a thick wetsuit and there is little opportunity to express yourself with colorful swimwear like in warmer places in California," Ahlgrim explained. She was hanging out at a surfboard laminating shop at the time and noticed the colorful waste collecting on the ground. She wanted to do something with the resin, and that creative inspiration birthed Surf Gems.



"My background is in art and sustainability studies from Cal Poly, and I was inspired to continue pursuing the craft and create something more from the material." She gathers the remnant "surf rocks" and uses her tools to turn them into earrings, necklaces and bolo ties.

While she loves making beautiful wearable art for herself and customers across the country, she simultaneously aims to cultivate a mindful and inquisitive approach to consumerism by working with a byproduct that would otherwise be thrown away. "People all over the place who own and wear [Surf Gems] and share them get to have conversations about where they come from and what they're wearing," Ahlgrim said. "My hope is that people think a little bit more about how things are made and think more about the behind the scenes and the mass amounts of waste that exist because of so much production on this planet."

You can find Surf Gems in boutiques around SLO CAL, online and at select pop-up markets. "I have really enjoyed watching Surf Gems grow throughout SLO County, California, Hawaii and on the East Coast. I ship all over the country!"

Mixed to Perfection


Lauren Butler, the co-owner and founder of Yes Cocktail Co., is passionate about supporting local farmers as she grows her successful cocktail accessory business headquartered in Paso Robles

auren Butler and her husband started Yes Cocktail Co. as a small farmers market business back in 2015. "We definitely didn't intend to expand to where we are today," she reflected. "We were at the right place at the right time: a global pandemic paired with a business that was perfect for drinking at home!"

Yes Cocktail Co. handcrafts artisanal, 100% natural cocktail mixers, garnishes, cubes and syrups. Their farmers market roots remain integral to the business; they strive to source everything from within a 50-mile radius and work with many local growers to source produce, herbs, spices and botanicals. For example, in the fall they released a hot honey syrup in collaboration with Paso Robles farmers, Sierra Honey Farms. "Everything we make is inspired by the area and the farmers we work with, and that makes it extra special."

Today, the company is housed in a 5,000-square-foot production facility, warehouse and tasting room in an up-and-coming area of Paso Robles named Union Road Collective. They offer zero-proof nonalcoholic mixology classes and tastings as well as spirited cocktail instruction. "Whether you're a seasoned pro or a very new to cocktail kind of person, we've got a class for you," Butler explained. "We can tailor it to any skill level of mixology experience."

They are also releasing a zeroproof amaro and nonalcoholic spirits to round out their offerings. In addition to visiting and sampling at the source, you can also find the Yes Cocktail Co. line at local distilleries and more than 3,000 retailers across the country.

Sensorio Paso Robles

Art, nature and technology converge at the magical **Sensorio Paso Robles**. After sunset, the hillsides light up with solar-powered immersive art installations created by artists Bruce Munro and the HYBYCOZO collective. Walk along glowing pathways through the colorful lights and linger over dinner at the on-site restaurant or food truck. An upgraded terrace experience grants access to a prime vantage point to look out over Munro's Field of Lights while enjoying food and beverage service and other VIP amenities.

The Great American Melodrama

A staple of Oceano dating back to 1975, **The Great American Melodrama** presents highly entertaining, comedic live professional theater followed by a vaudeville revue filled with song and dance. Staffed by actors, the throwback snack bar serves munchies, meals, sweet treats, beer and wine.

Lazy Arrow Adventures

Madonna Inn



Historic Chinatown

Designated Chinatown Historic District by the City of San Luis Obispo, the downtown block of Palm Street between Morro and Chorro streets was a thriving Chinatown. Among the few remaining original landmarks, the Ah Luis Store was the center of Chinatown from 1874 until 1930. Today, an event-planning company occupies the building and runs a gift shop that nods to the general store concept of its longtime owner. Mr. Ah Luis, a native of the Guangdong Province, was credited with bringing Chinese workers to the Central Coast to help build the railroad. Adjacent to the shop, a mural featuring the Chinese characters for "Love" and "Double Joy" celebrates the city's early Chinese residents. Across the street,





the vintage neon sign at **Mee Heng** Low noodle house beckons Chinese food lovers while **S. Low Bar** at nearby Hotel SLO pays homage to Chinatown with its neon Chop Suey sign.



SEEING STRIPES: Look inland along Highway 1 near **Hearst Castle** and you might spot a herd of zebras, the descendants of animals that were once part of the world's largest private zoo.

Originally a movie theater that first opened its doors in 1941, the historic **Fremont Theater** in downtown San Luis Obispo hosts live entertainment ranging from country and rock to festivals and comedy.

Avila Beach Golf Resort hosts an annual outdoor concert series May through October under the banner of "Concerts at the Cove." Every Saturday from April through July, Sea Pines Golf Resort in Los Osos presents "Barefoot Concerts on the Green."

The Siren is Morro Bay's go-to live music venue for "rhythm and booze," with local bands and touring acts on stage several nights a week. Old Cayucos Tavern features bands on weekends in its classic western saloon setting.

Basin Street Regulars Hot Jazz Club takes the jazz genre show on the road, presenting monthly gigs in different locales throughout the Central Coast on the last Sunday of the month. At the end of every October, the organization also hosts Jazz Jubilee Central Coast. San Luis Obispo Repertory Theatre has been presenting professional theatre to Central Coast audiences since 1947.
